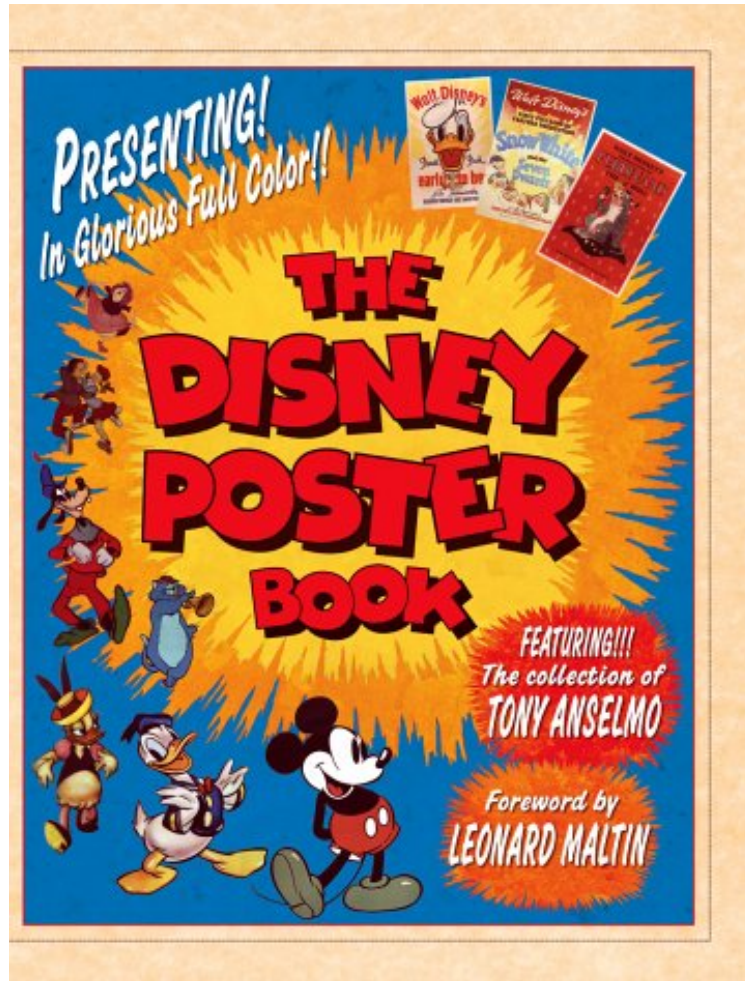

The book complements the similar Disney Poster Book published under the Hyperion label in the early '90's.
